




CHESHIRE SPENDS LESS ''OUT OF POCKET'' PER PUPIL

HIGHER % OF ED FUNDS FROM STATE & FEDS


RELATIVELY LOW % OF // SCHOOL FUNDING COMES FROM CHESHIRE


CHESHIRE'S MIDDLING MILL RATE
